Issues and challenges

Bourbon Offshore is a world leader in marine services and focuses on providing inspection, maintenance and repair services to the offshore oil and gas industry. It has a fleet of 250 vessels and a presence in 28 countries worldwide.

Two business-critical issues for the company are management of vessel costs and crew retention. However, a legacy satellite solution was delivering poor quality and reliability. Costs had doubled in recent years due to increased rates, usage and a cost-per-minute price structure. In addition, the satellite service provided only basic communications with minimal functionality.
